### **Companion Planting: Effects of Radishes on Squash Bugs**

Squash bugs are insects that lay their eggs on the undersides of leaves They are among the most prevalent garden bugs and can do an enormous amount of damage to squash plants and other cucurbits (Smith, 2017) The eggs will hatch in about ten days and over the next four to six weeks, the young squash bugs (nymphs) will grow into adults
